

NOTES TO LIST OF ACTOS

1. The Direct Recruit ACTOs and Combined Unit category ACTOs have been noted as such in the seniority lists and where no such indication is not available made, it represents the category of State Unit transferees.
2. The rank and seniority amongst the transferees has not been disturbed in the process of their confirmation against their quota of permanent post vacancies and wherever a senior has acted later than his junior, the provisos under Rule 35 (aa) of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services have been applied.
3. The provisions of Rule 35 (a) of the aforesaid Rules read with Rule 3 of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Commercial Taxes Subordinate Services have been applied in respect of candidates belonging to the Combined Unit category of the transferee list for each year.
4. In the years where there have been no direct recruitment but vacancies have arisen in their permanent post quota, the vacancies have been shown distinctly.
5. Whenever the direct recruits have joined duty in a particular year, they have been placed within their permanent quota vacancy in that year as per the guidelines confirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and their position in that year's list has been determined with reference to Rule 35 (aa) of the aforesaid Rules.
6. In terms of amendment to Special Rules made in G.O.Ms.No.501 CT & RE Department, dated 11.06.1985, with effect from 01.03.1982, the quota of 10% for combined unit in respect of confirmation in permanent vacancies has been omitted and quota to the extent of 66 2/3% alone has been provided for confirmation of transferees recruited by transfer of service. Therefore, no distinction has been made in respect of combined unit and state unit ACTOs in the lists from the year 1982 onwards and all transferees have been confirmed against their quota of permanent post vacancies in order of their seniority irrespective of the fact whether they belong to the Combined Unit or the State Unit. Hence, no indication has been made against combined unit ACTOs beginning from the list for the year 1982 and it has been left blank as in the case of State Unit ACTOs.
7. The transferee ACTOs who have been appointed for the years from 1982 to 2006 and whose names do not find mention in the seniority list have been included in

the list of temporary ACTOs appended to the end of the seniority list. They have been shown separately for the purpose of clarity only and their inclusion does not confer any right or seniority to be included in the permanent posts which shall be as per rules only. These ACTOs have been shown in the order of their seniority in each year's appointment list. This list includes persons who might have retired, dismissed or deceased.
